His research focused on clinical trials in bone marrow and stem cell transplantation, hematopoietic growth factors, treatment of acute leukemia, infections in neutropenic patients, multicenter trials in haematology and oncology, cytomegalovirus infection after stem cell transplantation. He has authored numerous publications in peer reviewed journals, textbooks on leukaemia, solid tumours, supportive care, infectious diseases, and serves as reviewer for several international journals. He is member of many international and national scientific and professional societies, and working on evidence based guidelines in solid tumours, supportive care, hematopoietic growth factors and infections.
